






Process of co-definition of policies

- 1) First diagnostic SWOT among experts & sector
- 2) Online open collaborative writing tool to collect proposals (**DemocracyOs**)
- 3) Procomuns event in March 2016
- With 400 people discussing proposals
- Institutional participation
- Declaration of public policies recommendations of 120 proposals
 - 4) PAM Decidim Barcelona: Online voting
